1. The Nazlini Chapter is a recognized governing entity of the Navajo Nation located within the boundaries of the Navajo Nation. It is endowed with perennial responsibilities to advocate for its citizens and community within the Navajo Nation; AND
2. The Nazlini Chapter is aware of the need for a Navajo Nation-wide Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System for any sudden occurrences of emergencies, and recognizes the lack of an effective emergency response; AND
3. The Nazlini Chapter acknowledges the need for establishment of an Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System on the Navajo Nation, to improve adequate communications and expedite emergency services; AND
4. Furthermore, the Nazlini Chapter genuinely believes those communities within Navajo Nation will not only benefit the people, but also public businesses, health care facilities, educational institutions, fire districts, emergency rescue personnel and police district.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:




