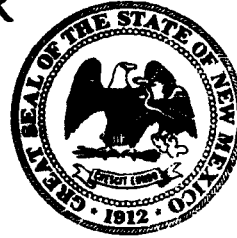

## RESOLUTION OF THE MANUELITO NAVAJO CHAPTER EASTERN NAVAJO AGENCY – DISTRICT 16

RESOLUTION NO: MANU-03-07-18

### Supporting and Endorsing the Completion of a Rural Addressing System, the Development and Implementation of a Navajo Nation Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System.

#### WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to Resolution CAP-34-98, the Navajo Nation Council adopted the Local Governance Act and by this Act delegated Navajo Nation Chapters the governmental authority to review all matters affecting the community and make sound decisions consistent with Navajo law, custom, and tradition; and
2. Manuelito Chapter is aware of the need for a Navajo Nation-wide Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System for any sudden occurrences of emergencies, and recognizes; and
3. Manuelito Chapter acknowledges the need for establishment of an Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System on the Navajo Nation, to improve adequate communications and expedite emergency services; and
4. Furthermore, the Manuelito Chapter genuinely believes these communities within Navajo Nation will not only benefit the people, but also public businesses, health care facilities, educational institutions, fire districts, emergency rescue personnel and police district.

#### NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

Manuelito Chapter hereby respectfully submits its support and endorsement in the implementation of a Rural Addressing System, commitment to help maintain the accuracy and subsequently, a Navajo Nation Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System, an effort by and through the Communications and Utilities Department of the Navajo Division of General Services.
