The Chapter hereby respectfully submits it support and endorsement of the implementation of a Rural Addressing System commitment to help maintain the accuracy and subsequently a Navajo Nation Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System an effort by through the Communications and Utilities Department of the Navajo Divisions of General Services.
