### SUPPORTING AND ENDORSING THE COMPLETION OF A RURAL ADDRESSING SYSTEM AND THE DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A NAVAJO NATION ENHANCED EMERGENCY 911 SYSTEM

#### WHEREAS:

1. The Hogback Community Chapter is certified Chapter of the Navajo Tribal Resolution COA-23-78 and has the authority to enact upon all social and economic needs of its community people; AND
2. The Hogback Community is delegated and authorized with the responsibility to plan, implement and monitor all chapter community projects that will benefit the community resident; AND
3. The Hogback Community is aware of the need for a Navajo Nation-wide Enhanced Emergency 911 System for any sudden occurrence of emergencies, and recognized the lack of an effective emergency response; AND
4. The Hogback Community Chapter acknowledges the need for establishment of an Enhanced Emergency 911 System on the Navajo Nation, to improve adequate communication and expedite emergency services; AND
5. Furthermore, the Hogback Chapter believes those communities within the Northern Navajo Agency will not only benefit the people, but also public business, health care facilities, educational institution, fire department, emergency rescue personnel and Police district.

#### NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:




#### CERTIFICATION




