RESOLUTION OF MEXICAN WATER CHAPTER

Approve to support the completion of a Rural Addressing System and the Development and Implementation of a Navajo Nation Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System.

WHEREAS,

1. The Mexican Water Chapter is a duly called certified Chapter pursuant to 26 N.N.C. Section 3 and Pursuant to 11 N.N.C. Part 1, Section 10; and
2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C. Section 103 (A), the members of each Chapter, at a duly called meeting, are authorized to oversee the authority delegated to the Chapter pursuant to this Act: and
3. The Mexican Water Chapter is delegated the authority and responsibility to plan and implement community projects to seek and obtain federal funds for the benefit of local residents; and
4. The Mexican Water Chapter is aware of the need for a Navajo Nation-wide Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System for any sudden occurrences of emergencies, and recognizes the lack of an effective emergency response; and
5. The Mexican Water acknowledges the need for establishment of an Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System on the Navajo Nation, to improve adequate communications and expedite emergency services; and
6. Furthermore, the Mexican Water chapter genuinely believes those communities within Navajo Nation will not only benefit the people, but also public businesses, health care facilities, educational institutions, fire districts, emergency rescue personnel and police district; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT;

1. The Mexican Water Chapter hereby approves to support the completion of a Rural Addressing System and the Development and Implementation of a Navajo Nation Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System, and subsequently, a Navajo Nation Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System, an effort by and through the communications Utilities Department of the Navajo Nation Division of General Services.
