SUPPORTING THE COMPLETION OF THE NAVAJO RURAL ADDRESSING SYSTEM AND THE DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A NAVAJO NATION ENHANCED EMERGENCY 9-1-1 COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Shiprock Chapter of the Navajo Nation acts on this resolution pursuant to the authority conferred to the Chapter through Navajo Nation Code Title 26, Chapter 1.B. Purpose, which states, "Through adoption of this Act, the Navajo Nation Council delegates to Chapters governmental authority with respect to local matters consistent with Navajo Law, including custom and tradition;" and
- The Shiprock Chapter is aware of and recognizes the need for a Navajo Nationwide Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System to facilitate quick response to sudden occurrences of emergencies: and
- The Shiprock Chapter acknowledges the need for the establishment of a Navajo Nation Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System to improve adequate communications and to expedite emergency services; and
- 4. The Shiprock Chapter further genuinely believes those communities within the Navajo Nation will not only benefit the people, but also public businesses, health care facilities, educational institutions, fire districts, emergency rescue personnel and the law enforcement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The membership of the Shiprock Chapter hereby respectfully submits its support and endorsement in the implementation of a Rural Addressing System, and commits to help maintain the accuracy of a Navajo Nation Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System, which is an effort by and through the Communications and Utilities Department of the Navajo Division of General Services.
