SHONTO COMMUNITY GOVERNANCE OF THE NAVAJO NATION SH05-01-07

SUPPORTING AND ENDORSING THE COMPLETION OF A RURAL ADDRESSING SYSTEM AND THE DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A NAVAJO NATION WIDE ENHANCED EMERGENCY 9-1-1 SYSTEM.

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to TCDCS-98-99, The Transportation and Community Development approved the Governance Ccrification of the Five Management System Policies and Procedures for Shonto Chapter, pursuant to the Local Governance Act, 26 N.N.C. Section 102 (B); and
- 2. Shonto Community Governance is a local certified Chapter of the Navajo Nation Government with vested authority and responsibility to develop and implement local ordinances and to approve plans and take positions on matters of local concern that are in the best interest of the local chapter and Navajo Nation; and
- 3. In January 2003, the Navajo Nation Council Government Services Committee of the Navajo Nation via Resolution GSCJA-09-03 took the actions that supported the development of a Navajo Nation Wide 9-1-1 Emergency Communication Services and recommending that the Navajo Nation Council recognize and support the development. The committee also directed the Director of Communications and Utilities to research and coordinate with the necessary Division and Offices to recommend the most efficient and effective Emergency 911 System to be established within the Navajo Nation; and
- 4. The Navajo Nation through task forces started the development of the 911 System, to assemble a plan and to coordinate the implementation, assembled supporting resolutions from the five agencies, developed an Public Education plan, issue a bi-monthly newsletter, developed a website and continues to proceed other aspects of the initiative; and
- 5. The Shonto Community Governance deems it in the best interest of its community and the Navajo Nation to support the Navajo Nation efforts to complete the rural addressing and the implementation of the 911 system.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Shonto Community Governance supports and endorses the completion of the Rural Address System and the Implementation of a Navajo Nation Wide Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 System.
